INTRODUCTION

In accordance with Section 72 of the Access to Information Act, the International Development Research Centre is hereby pleased to submit its annual report to Parliament as required by the Act.

The report is necessarily brief since no requests for information were received during the reporting period under the provisions of the Access to Information Act.

IMPLEMENTATION

The Centre reviewed the steps taken during the implementation phase to ensure that appropriate systems and procedures were in place for the effective control and direction of all Access to Information requests.

MODIFICATIONS TO THE ACCESS REGISTER

The entries to the Access Register were reviewed.

Modifications were made in accordance with the new format established by the Treasury Board Secretariat. Only minor textual revisions were required to update the existing information.

STATISTICAL REPORTS

The International Development Research Centre has not received any requests for information under the Act during the period July 1, 1984 to June 30, 1985. Quarterly reports reflecting this lack of activity were provided to Treasury Board as required under Part IV of the Interim Policy Guide.

COSTS

There have been no costs in providing services under the Access to Information Act. No funds have been spent on any additional facilities or equipment. In addition, a very limited amount of time was spent by the coordinator on matters relating to the Act, namely attendance at sessions and some internal contacts.
