Preparation of this Bibliography

This indexed bibliography was compiled to assist leaders and staff of IDRC-supported projects in retrieving information relevant to their particular interests. The titles are listed in alphabetical order by authors' names. Taxonomic and subject indexes are provided to ease the retrieval process.

The articles included were obtained as a result of: manual searching of journals, *Aquatic Sciences and Fisheries Abstracts*, *Agrindex* and *Agriasia*, books, and current awareness computer profiles; retrospective searches on specific subjects; and requests of researchers on particular topics.

This bibliography has also been sent to researchers who are associated with IDRC-supported Fisheries projects and to institutions and organizations which are either associated with the IDRC-supported projects or with whom IDRC has a reciprocal publication exchange.
